Enclosed is our tentative plan to open our temple. Following the guidelines provided is utmost important for all of us for our safety. We know we all will accept our responsibility.

We intend to open Jain temple Sunday July 5th, 2020 only on alternate Sunday's.

- 1. Jain Temple will be opened only on Sundays for only 3 hours from 9AM to 12:00 PM NO weekdays at all.
- 2. NO Keys will be given to any one on any other days by HTW to Temple Hall except Sundays
- 3. All JRCW members will be informed ahead of time about certain rules of opening and restrictions
- 4. When Temple opened, it be monitored by two JRCW volunteers who are on duty Sundays
- 5. Only 6 people maximum at a time
- 6. Please make sure you wear a mask when you enter the temple. Otherwise you will need to buy one at the temple.
- 7. Do not dispose the masks in the temple premises.
- 8. Devotes to bring their own Maalaas(Rosary) and take back home
- 9. Devotees to bring their own folding cloth to seat and take it back
- 10. Devotees to bring their own books for chanting poojas
- 11. Do Not touch any surface as every surface will be cleaned during each opening
- 12. All Carpets will be rolled away NOT to be used
- 13. Pooja room will be (locked) inaccessible to Devotees, Special arrangement will be made to lock that will be accessible to authorized personnel only
- 14. No entry into the Gabhara, or Poojas to be performed
- 15. Gabhara doors will be open
- 16. There will be no activities at this time in Library hall
